

Security

The security system for visitors to Kiddie Korner consists of a three part security tag. Each tag has a three digit number located on all three parts of the tag.

The first part of the tag serves as a name tag and is placed on the child's back. It also provides caregivers with other information such as allergies, where to

located the parents if they are needed, and whether the child is potty training, etc.

The second part of the tag is given to the parent and serves as identification when the child is picked up

Parents must have a security tag to pick up their children!

The third part of the security tag is a label to identify your child's belongings such as a bag, bottle, or jacket.

The three digit number is also used with our call system. There are two digital display monitors located in the sanctuary. If your child needs you, his or her number will be displayed. Please, go immediately to your child's room.

Members and regular attendees of LBC have permanent ID tags that are worn and used the same way as the sticker system.

Our goal is to provide a secure and happy environment for you and your child.

If you have any questions, problems, or suggestions, please feel free to call the church office or speak with the nursery/preschool director.

What is expected of the parents?

- **If you are a visitor, please fill out the security tag completely. It helps us to better care for your child and to locate you quickly, if you are needed.**
- **If you have a permanent ID card, please make sure your child's tag is properly attached to his/her back and that you have your parent card.**
- **Please label everything that belongs to your child including Bibles, bags, bottles, cups, and pacifiers.**
- **For a successful family ministry, parents of nursery/preschool children are strongly encouraged to serve in Kiddie Korner during one service a month.**

All children cry sometimes when being left by parents. We understand and expect it. In most cases, crying stops a few moments after you leave. If your child continues to cry after five to ten minutes, we will notify you.

You are encouraged to help your child to feel comfortable while they are at Kiddie Korner by staying in the room as long as you would like.

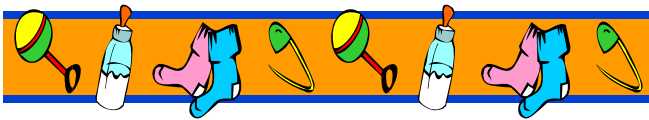

Our mission is to encourage each child's spiritual, intellectual, social, and physical development as we introduce them to Jesus Christ.

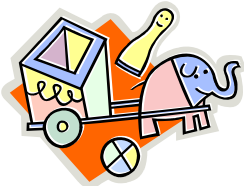


Nursery/Preschool Structure and Promotion

Teal, Lavender, Gold, and Red rooms are for infants, crawlers, and young walkers. Children in these rooms will enjoy swings, exersaucers, soothing music, and lots of floor space to move about. The **Green** and **Hot Pink** rooms are for older walkers. Children are promoted into these rooms according to their developmental progress as needed to help control class size.

The **Orange, Lt. Blue, Lime, and Silver** rooms are for two and three year olds. Children in these rooms will enjoy a Bible-based curriculum that includes a story and related crafts, music, and movement activities. Children will stay in these rooms until after their third birthday and will be promoted as a class, usually in June.

Yellow, Peach, Purple, and Navy rooms are for children aged four through pre-kindergarten. Children in these rooms will enjoy a Bible-based curriculum that includes a story and related crafts, music, and movement activities. Children are promoted as a class each June. Children entering kindergarten will be promoted into the Kidz Street children's ministry as a class in June.



Availability

Kiddie Korner is open every Sunday and Wednesday for regularly scheduled church services and for special church events as announced.

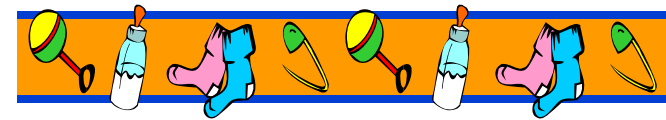
The rooms will be open 15 minutes prior to the beginning of the service and close approximately 15 minutes after the service ends. Please pick up your children promptly.

Kiddie Korner Sunday school begins at 9:30. Activities that reinforce the Sunday school lesson are provided for the 11:00 service.

A nursing mother's room is located upstairs, across from room 272.

Caregivers

Kiddie Korner rooms are staffed with two to four caregivers. All of our caregivers are volunteers. Caregivers are required to wear a Kiddie Korner name tag to identify themselves. We strive to meet very specific ratios of adults to children so that no caregiver is supervising more than three infants, four walkers, five toddlers, or eight preschoolers. Because of this, when you check in your child, you may be asked to stay and work during that service.



Good Health Guidelines

We want to provide a healthy environment in our nursery, so we ask you to keep your child at home when you observe any of the following:

- Fever or vomiting
- Discharge in or around the eyes
- Green or yellow runny nose
- Excessive coughing
- Diarrhea
- Questionable rash
- Any communicable disease

If your child becomes ill while in Kiddie Korner, you will be notified promptly.

If your child is being treated with an antibiotic, he or she should have received treatment for at least 24 hours before coming to Kiddie Korner.

For your child's protection, we ask our caregivers to follow these same guidelines.

Our goal is to make Kiddie Korner as healthy and clean as possible. Some of the ways we do this include: wiping down the toys and equipment after each session, using gloves to change diapers, and changing the bedding after every use. We also offer periodic CPR classes.
