

Unit 15, Session 4

Questions for Discussion

(Blue questions are geared toward kids ages 3rd-5th grade.)

1. **How should we treat others who are different from us? Why?** *(Every person matters to God. We should treat everyone with respect and honor because they are made in God's image. All people are loved by God and were made to know Him. We can show others what God is like when we show them love and respect.)*
2. **Why can we not escape God?** *(God is everywhere. He is bigger than all creation and can be in all places at once. God is all powerful and able to know everything about all things.)*
3. **Why is it good news that God knows everything about you?** *(It is good news that God knows everything about us because He still chose to send Jesus to rescue us from sin. God already knows the sin we have done and the sin we will do, but He still chooses to save us from our sin. Be quick to repent of sin because God already knows. Everyone matters to God and in Jesus we can find forgiveness.)*
4. **Why did David say he is fearfully and wonderfully made?** *(All people are fearfully and wonderfully made because they are created by God. The truth that God knows all people and formed them in His image makes them a wonderful creation. We are fearfully made because we were made to stand in awe of God. We were made to know God. Read Colossians 1:16).*
5. **How would you encourage someone who does not feel very loved?** *(Every person matters to God. God sees and knows every person. No one is hidden from Him. Think about ways you can show others that they matter and are loved by being a friend. Read 1 John 4:7-9)*
6. **How should being made in God's image affect the way we live?** *(Being made in God's image means we are called to reflect what God is like to the world. Jesus perfectly showed people what God is like because He was the image of the invisible God. Others can see the character of God in our lives when we fight against sin and ask Him to help us look more like Jesus. Encourage kids to look to Jesus to help them walk in His ways. Read Ephesians 4:22-24)*
