Reflection and Prayer Time

Here are a couple of ideas for you and your child(ren) to do after you discuss the Bible story to help them think about what they have learned and how they can apply it in their own lives.

- Have your children draw a picture, talk, or write about the following questions:
 - \circ $\,$ What does this story teach me about God or the gospel?
 - What does the story teach me about myself?
 - Are there any commands in this story to obey? How are they for God's glory and my good?
 - Are there any promises in this story to remember? How do they help me trust and love God?
 - How does this story help me to live on mission better?
 - Have you ever been convicted of making yourself more important than God or others?

Take some time to pray together with your child. Encourage them to voice their prayers or ask if they have any special prayer requests.

- Make a list of people or issues to pray about each day this week and encourage your kids to pray each day this week about one item on the list.
- Later in the week ask your child(ren) to retell you the story you talked about Sunday.
 - Who can you tell this week about the good news that Jesus has made a way for us to repent and be forgiven of our sins?
