Questions for Discussion

(Blue questions are geared toward kids ages 3rd-5th grade.)

1. **What are ways people try to make themselves great?** (*We can turn good gifts or abilities into ways to bring praise to our own names. Building a tower is not bad, but when the people used the tower to make their name great, their actions became sinful. Kids might brag about what they own or their special athletic abilities or their grades to make their names great.*)
2. **Why is only God great?** (*God is the Creator and King of everything. Everything exists because He made it to bring glory to His name. Only God is perfect and never sins. We were made to worship Him and find true joy in knowing Him.*)
3. **How can we show others that only God is great and deserves worship?** (*We can make God's name great by telling others about His love, forgiveness, and salvation through Jesus. Everyone needs to hear the good news of the gospel. All people sin and no one can get to heaven by good works, making their name great, or trying to earn God's love. Jesus changes our hearts so that our greatest desire is to worship God. Sharing the gospel is one way we worship God.*)
4. **What do you think it means to worship God?** (*Worshipping God means that we acknowledge and praise His great worth. God is greater and worth more than anything. We can worship God with every part of our lives, including loving Him with all our heart, mind, soul, and strength. Read 1 Samuel 12:24.*)
5. **Why was it good that God confused the people's language?** (*Sin is disobeying God and His commands. Sin leads to death. When God stopped the people's plans to build the tower, He did so for their good. Following God's ways leads to life. Read Deuteronomy 12:28.*)
6. **How can we trust that God has good plans for our lives?** (*God has shown He has good planned for us through His Son Jesus. God's greatest plan for our lives is to know Him and worship Him. Through faith in Jesus, we have forgiveness of sin, eternal life, and can live in ways that honor God. Read Ephesians 1:3-10.*)
